



## Sahih Bukhari English

The Most Authenticated Book of Hadith

Muhammad Ibn Ismail al-Bukhari popularly known as Imam Bukhari, (810-870AD), was a Sunni Islamic scholar. He authored the Hadith collection named *Sahih Bukhari*, a collection which Sunni Muslims regard as the most authentic of all Hadith compilations. Bukhari wrote three works discussing narrators of Hadith with respect to their ability in conveying their material: the "brief compendium of Hadith narrators," "the medium compendium" and the "large compendium". The large compendium is published and well-identified.

In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful

## Shuf'a is valid if the property is undivided

Hadith # # 2257

**Narrated Jabir bin `Abdullah:**

Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) gave a verdict regarding Shuf'a in every undivided joint thing (property). But if the limits are defined (or demarcated) or the ways and streets are fixed, then there is no pre-emption.

## The partner should inform his partner before selling

Hadith # # 2258

**Narrated `Amr bin Ash-Sharid:**

While I was standing with Sa`d bin Abi Waqqas, Al-Miswar bin Makhrama came and put his hand on my shoulder. Meanwhile Abu Rafi`, the freed slave of the Prophet (ﷺ) came and asked Sa`d to buy from him the (two) dwellings which were in his house.

Sa`d said, "By Allah I will not buy them." Al- Miswar said, "By Allah, you shall buy them."

Sa`d replied, "By Allah, I will not pay more than four thousand (Dirhams) by installments."

Abu Rafi` said, "I have been offered five hundred Dinars (for it) and had I not heard the Prophet (ﷺ) saying,

'The neighbor has more right than anyone else because of his nearness, I would not give them to you for four-thousand (Dirhams) while I am offered five-hundred Dinars (one Dinar equals ten Dirhams) for them.'

So, he sold it to Sa`d.

**Narrated Aisha:**

I said, "O Allah's Messenger (ﷺ)! I have two neighbors and would like to know to which of them I should give presents."

He replied, "To the one whose door is nearer to you."
