Abdullah Yusuf Ali, (1872 –1953) was an Islamic scholar who translated the Qur'an into English. His translation of the Qur'an is one of the most widely-known and used in the English-speaking world. In his childhood, Ali received a religious education and could recite the entire Qur'an from memory. He spoke both Arabic and English fluently. (Mankind)

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

1	قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ النَّاسِ Say: I seek refuge with the Lord and Cherisher of Mankind,
2	مَلِكِ النَّاسِ The King (or Ruler) of Mankind,
3	إِلَهِ النَّاسِ The Allah (or Judge) of Mankind --
4	مِنْ شَرِّ الْوَسْوَاسِ الْخَنَّاسِ From the mischief of the Whisperer (of Evil), who withdraws (after his whisper) --

5	<p>الَّذِي يُوسِّسُ فِي صُدُورِ النَّاسِ</p> <p>(The same) who whispers into the hearts of mankind --</p>
6	<p>مِنَ الْجِنَّةِ وَالنَّاسِ</p> <p>Among Jinns and among Men._</p> <p>*****</p>
